Dr. Luke Forau is the Governor of the Central Bank of Solomon Islands. He was appointed Governor on the 1st of October 2019. Before that he was serving as the Deputy Governor from September 2018 until September 30th 2019. He has been with the Central Bank since January 1999.

Dr. Luke Forau is also the current President and Chairman for the Economic Association of Solomon Islands (EASI)

He holds a Doctor in Philosophy (PhD) in the field of Economics from the University of New South Wales Canberra, a Master of International and Development Economics award from the Australian National University in Canberra, and a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Management and Public Administration and Economics from the University of South Pacific.
