INFORMATION FOR TRAVELLERS AND EMIGRANTS

- It is an offence to take out of the Solomon Islands more than \$250 in notes and/or coin that is legal tender in the Solomon Islands. Penalties can include forfeiture of the money.
- Currency issued for travel expenditure must not be used for other purposes e.g. purchase of overseas investments.
- There may be difficulty in some overseas countries in exchanging Solomon Islands currency – either travellers' cheques or notes – and it is advisable to take a more internationally recognised currency to meet expenses in such countries.
- Securities or gold may not be taken abroad without special permission from the Solomon Islands Monetary Authority. An approval may be necessary to take valuable furs, jewellery and certain other items of personal or household effects – you should check with your bank or travel agent about this.
